Research Interests / Specialization

Since my area of specialization is international business, I would like to continue my research work in the same area and explore the various dimensions and issues involved in the conduct of international business. Some of these dimensions that I find of particular interest are foreign direct investment (FDI), trade liberalization, ease of doing business and international tax environment.
