As you are aware, Swachh Bharat Mission (Grameen) has been recognized as the largest behavioral change program in the world. It represents the influential force of people's movement or Jan-Andolan that transformed the lives of our people, bringing significant improvement in terms of economic, environmental, health and social benefits, and enhanced the safety and dignity of women of our country.

2. With SBMG Phase – II taking confident strides towards achieving 100% ODF Plus Model status, there is a greater need to intensify our efforts towards the objective of making all our villages as ODF Plus Model by March 2025. To aid the progress and to evaluate the outcomes that have been achieved under SBM-G, we propose to acknowledge and suitably reward selected research papers to be undertaken by the States/ UTs / RWPF partners/ select Central and State Universities according to the time schedule indicated in the appended Guidelines.

3. States/UT/RWPF partner/ select Central and State Universities (as per list attached) are requested to identify and submit abstracts (around 500 words) on 3-5 research areas aligned with different SBM-G verticals.

4. All abstracts to be shared by the State/UTs' need to be recommended by the State Secretary- in-charge of rural sanitation. The abstracts from RWPF partners may be sent to DDWS for scrutiny and recommendation while the abstracts from the Central and State Universities need to be scrutinised and recommended by the respective Hon'ble Vice Chancellor/ HoD of the Central/State University. The last date for submission of abstracts is 15th July, 2024.

5. The evaluation of all the abstracts will be done at DDWS based on relevance, originality, innovation, methodological rigor, and practical implications.

6. The research paper will be sought on the selected abstract(s) only. The last date for submission of the research paper is 30th October 2024.

7. The selected research paper(s) will be rewarded suitably at a National event.

SBM-G Phase-II is pleased to announce a call for research papers from all States/UTs/RWPF partners/ select Central and National Universities. This initiative aims to gather cutting-edge research on all the components of our Mission and to help achieve the objective of making all our villages ODF Plus Model status.

Submission Guidelines

Eligibility

- Open to all States/UTs/RWPF partners/ Select Central and National Universities
- The paper must be aligned with the theme of rural sanitation and its sustainable Operation and Maintenance (O&M).
- Submissions may encompass research conducted at a minimum district level, with a preference for studies conducted at the district, cluster of districts or higher administrative level bringing out comprehensive insights into sanitation challenges and solutions.
- RWPF partners must get the approval of DDWS before finalizing the subject of Research paper. Accordingly, ideas for research maybe got approved on priority basis through close co-ordination.
- States/UTs must get the approval of State Secretary, Rural Sanitation before finalizing the subject of Research paper.

All abstracts shared by the State/UTs' need to be scrutinised and recommended by the State Secretary- in-charge of rural sanitation. All abstracts shared from the Central and State Universities need to be scrutinised and recommended by the respective Hon'ble Vice Chancellor/ HoD of the Central/State University.

Research Themes

Submissions should focus on, but are not limited to, the following themes:

- Innovative sanitation technologies and its impact on sanitation post adoption in States/UTs.
- Operation & Maintenance (O&M) mechanism for sustainability and its impact on sanitation systems
- Behavioural change communication strategies for improved sanitation and its optimum utilisation.
- Impact of sanitation interventions on health and well-being.
- Community-led total sanitation approaches.
- Research on impacts/outcomes in NMCG villages, Aspirational blocks, districts, SAGY villages etc.
- Research on impacts/outcomes in all the verticals of SBM-G.

Submission Process

- Identify at least 3-5 subjects for research paper
