- The evaluation of all the abstracts will be done at DDWS based on relevance, originality, innovation, methodological rigor, and practical implications.
- The research paper will be sought on the selected abstract(s) only. The last date for submission of the research paper is 30th October 2024.
- The selected research paper(s) will be rewarded suitably at a National event. 7.


