GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

- 1. Students shall be sent the question paper through email on the email address as mentioned by them in the examination form.
- 2. Students are advised to answer the questions on A4 sheets.
- 3. On the first page, the students shall write the following details:
 - a. Date and time of examination (DD/MM/YYYY, HRS:Min)
 - b. Examination Roll No.
 - c. Name of the Programme
 - d. Semester
 - e. Paper Code and Unique paper code (if any)
 - f. Paper Title
- 4. The duration of the examination shall be 4 hours. Out of which 3 hours shall be given to the students for answering the questions, and the remaining one hour shall be utilized by the students for downloading the question papers, scanning the answer sheet in the PDF format and uploading the answer script
- 5. The duration of the examination shall be 6 hours for the students belonging to the Divyang (Pwd) category.
 - Important: In case of poor connectivity / any unforeseen technical glitches etc., the student is advised to submit his/ her script beyond the specified time period with the documentary evidence on the respective email address mentioned against the programme code. However, all such cases will be examined by the Review Committee and these answer sheets shall be evaluated based on the decision of Review Committee. Students should keep a track of DU website for notices regarding OBE.
